#### **VISIT TO THE BIOBANK**

On Thursday, 31 October at 2.00pm, several Carers went to the hospital to see the Biobank the Carers bought in November 2022.



First we visited this room that is where patients' blood phials are taken for initial analysis by Ashleigh Splitt. It is in the CCC, Level 2.

#### 3 Illawarra Cancer Carers

We then proceeded downstairs to the basement where the all samples are securely stored (as you can see). The vapour phase liquid nitrogen (LN2) tank holds 6000 cryovials (samples) in total There are six racks in full.





These samples are stored in 100 place cyroboxes, with each rack (as pictured) holding 10 boxes.

These samples can be stored for many years in The LN2 tank without loss of cell viability and therefore can be used for research many years after they were collected.


