#### **FAREWELL TO A VERY SPECIAL CARER**

Just prior to emailing this Newsletter earlier I received the sad news of Eleanor Symons passing this morning.

Eleanor was one of the first persons to answer an Illawarra Mercury advertisement in November 1990 for volunteers to join the Cancer Carers. She was our second President who really got the Cancer Carers established as an official organisation by registering the Incorporation and the Charity status of the Cancer Carers. Eleanor planned the start of our caring in Ward 15 (Now C7); set up a roster initially for three mornings a week; insufficient numbers for five days. She and other early Carers were very involved in setting up Alkira Lodge, making accommodation suitable for those from afar whose spouse was in Wollongong hospital with cancer.

After the first Picnic on the Manor (run by nurses), Eleanor was Chairperson of this subcommittee for several years. The Cork Collection fundraiser was properly established under her guidance; had the Sewing Group making bags for cork collection at so many outlets; delegated collectors; her husband Philip stored them until there were sufficient for free delivery of corks to Melbourne.

Eleanor was a good organiser, a deep thinker and acknowledged volunteers' abilities for delegation and personal involvement.

More recently she returned to the Sewing Group, something she participated in from its earliest days

Eleanor will be sadly missed by us all. RIP




